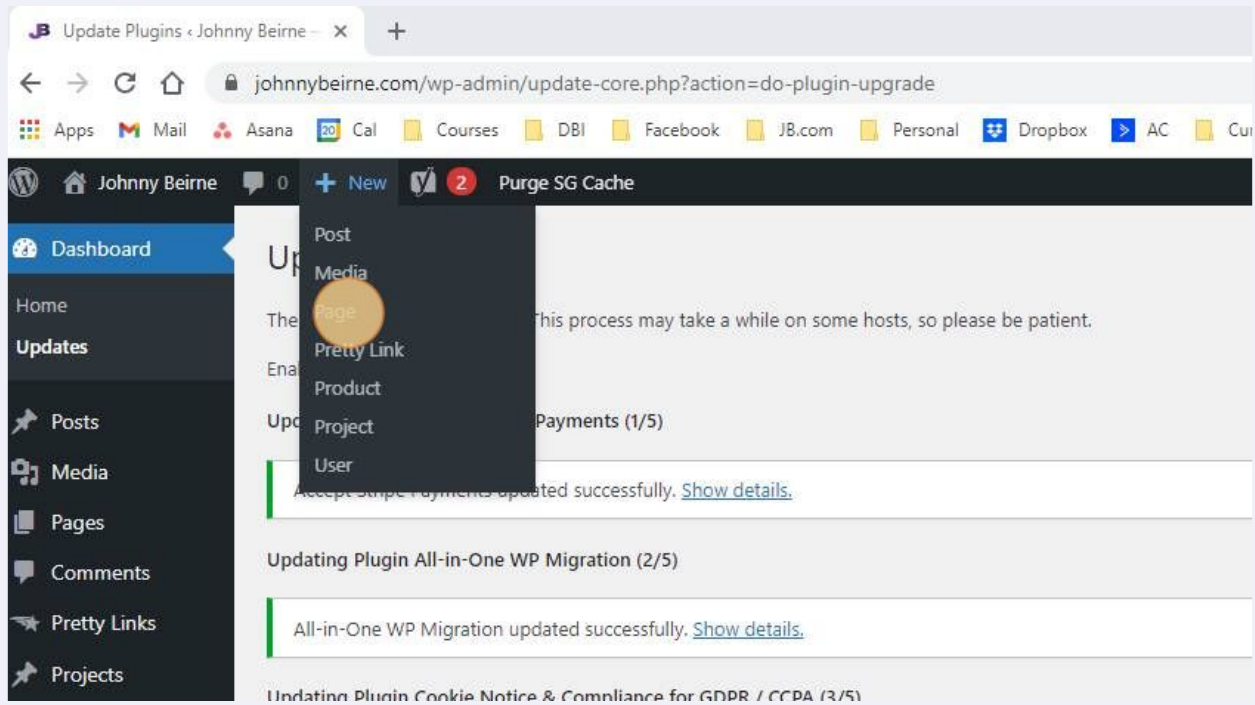


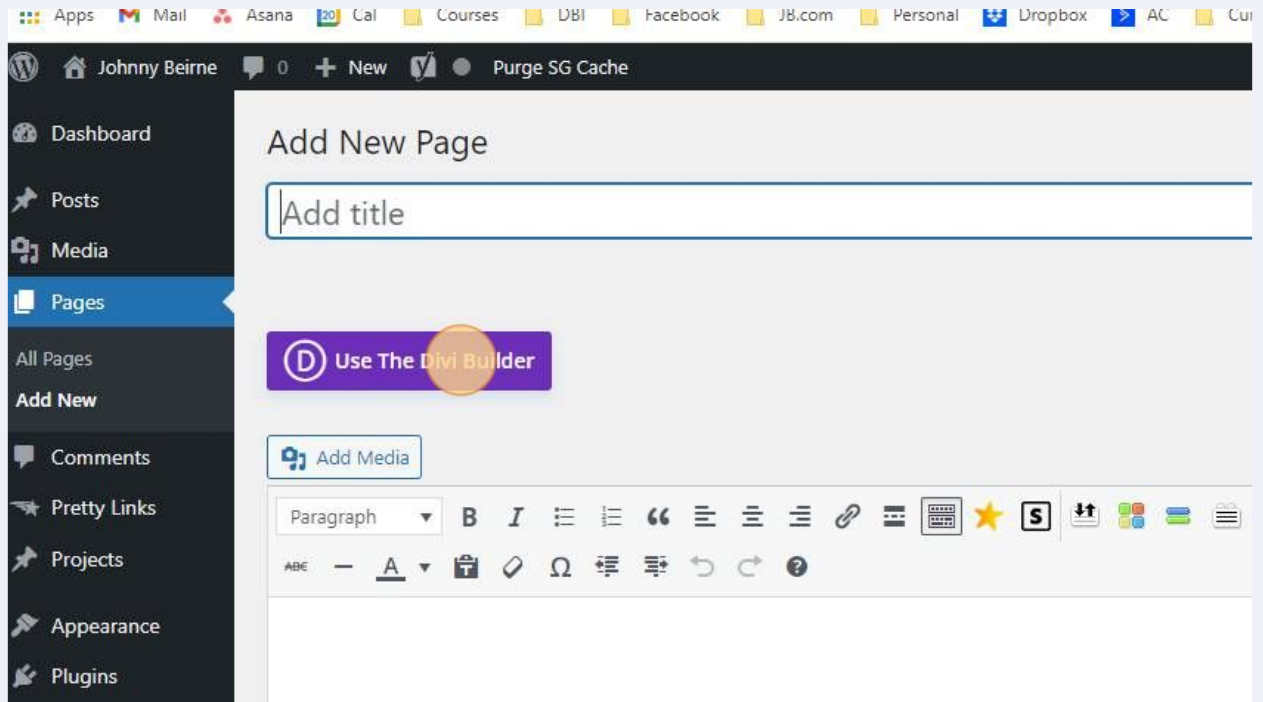
Duplicate an Existing Page

How to create a copy of one of your existing website pages.

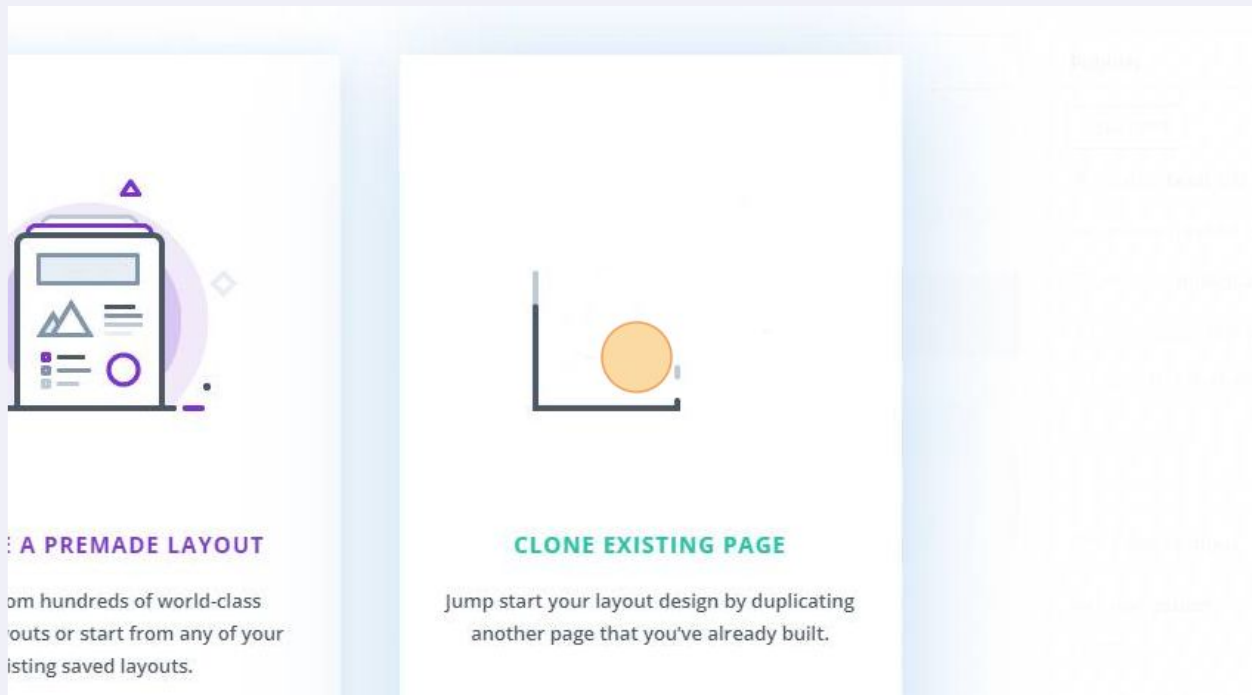
1 Add New Page



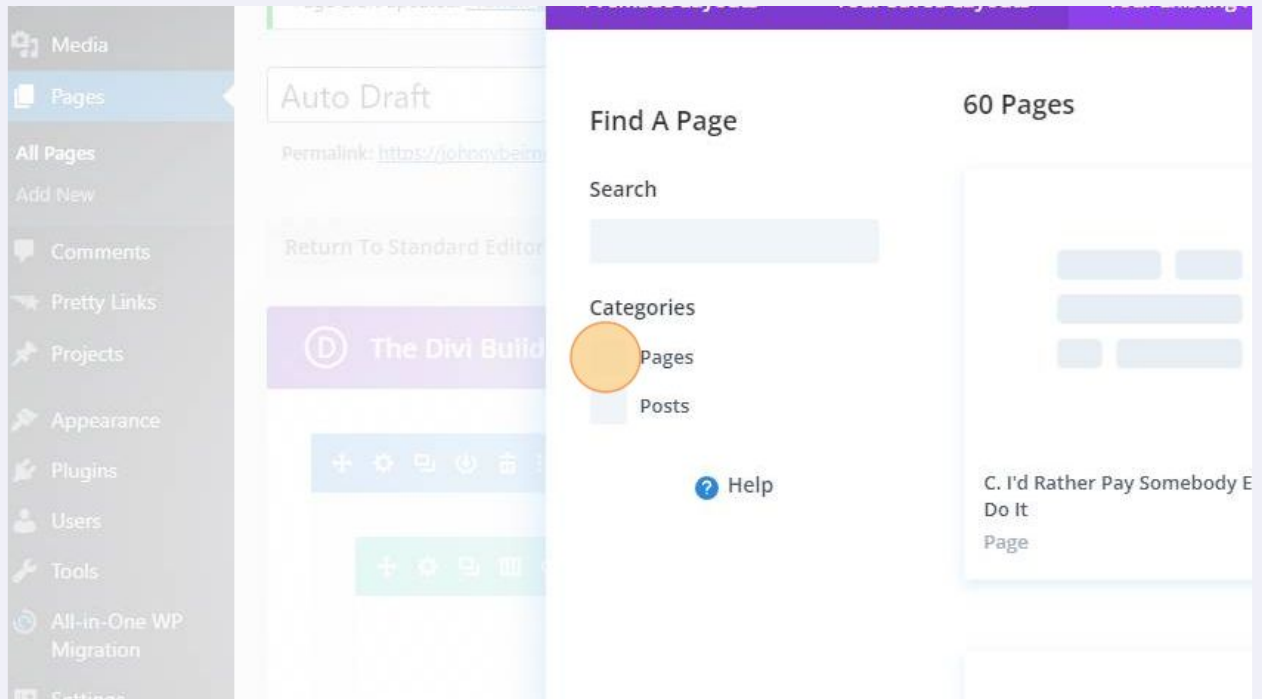
2 Click "Use The Divi Builder"



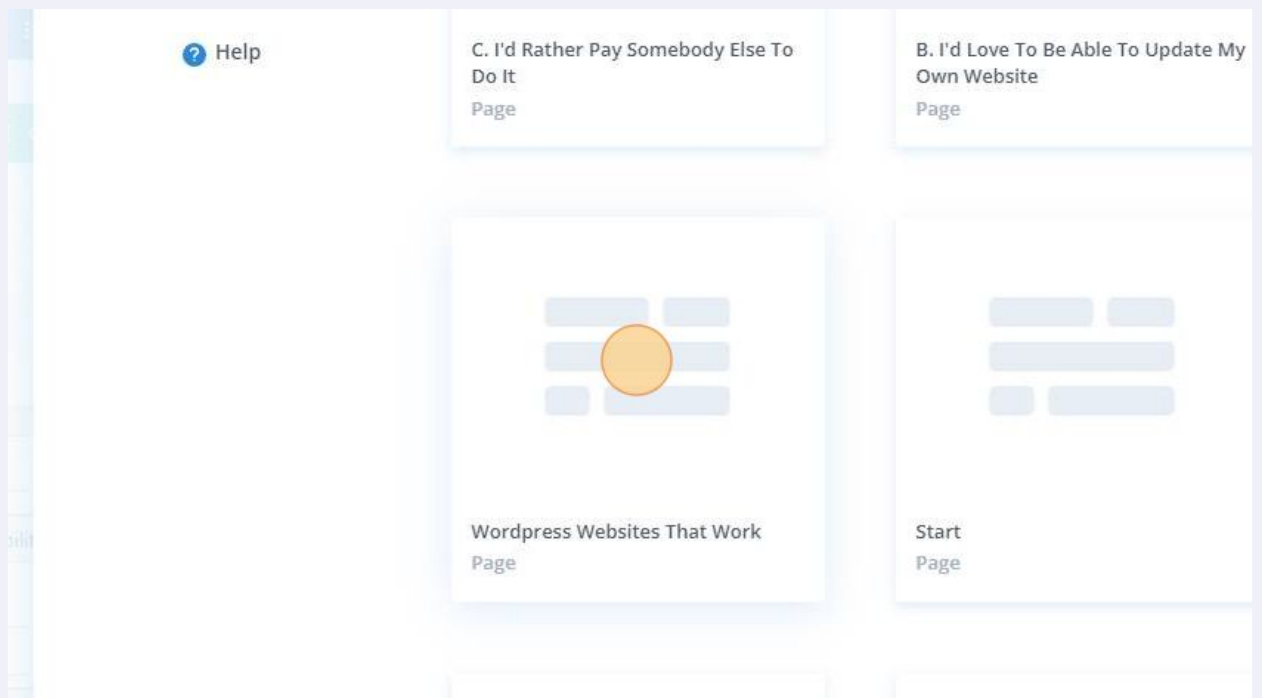
3 Click "Clone Existing page"



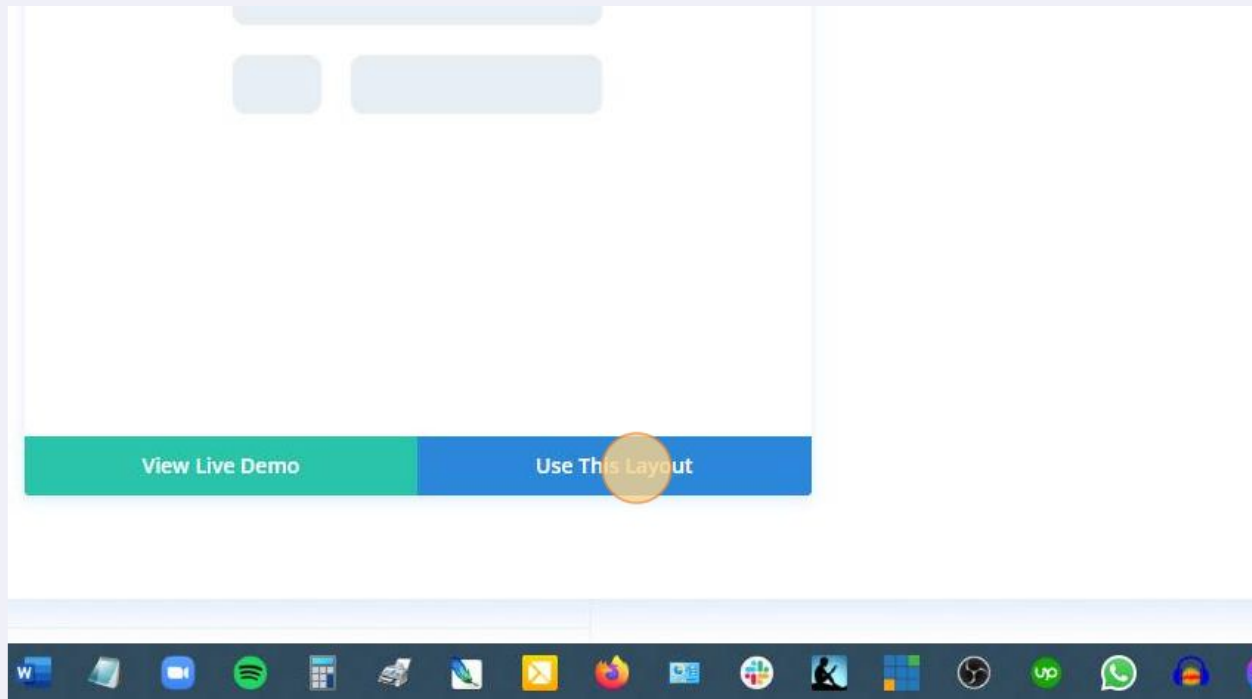
4 Click "Pages" to just show your existing pages



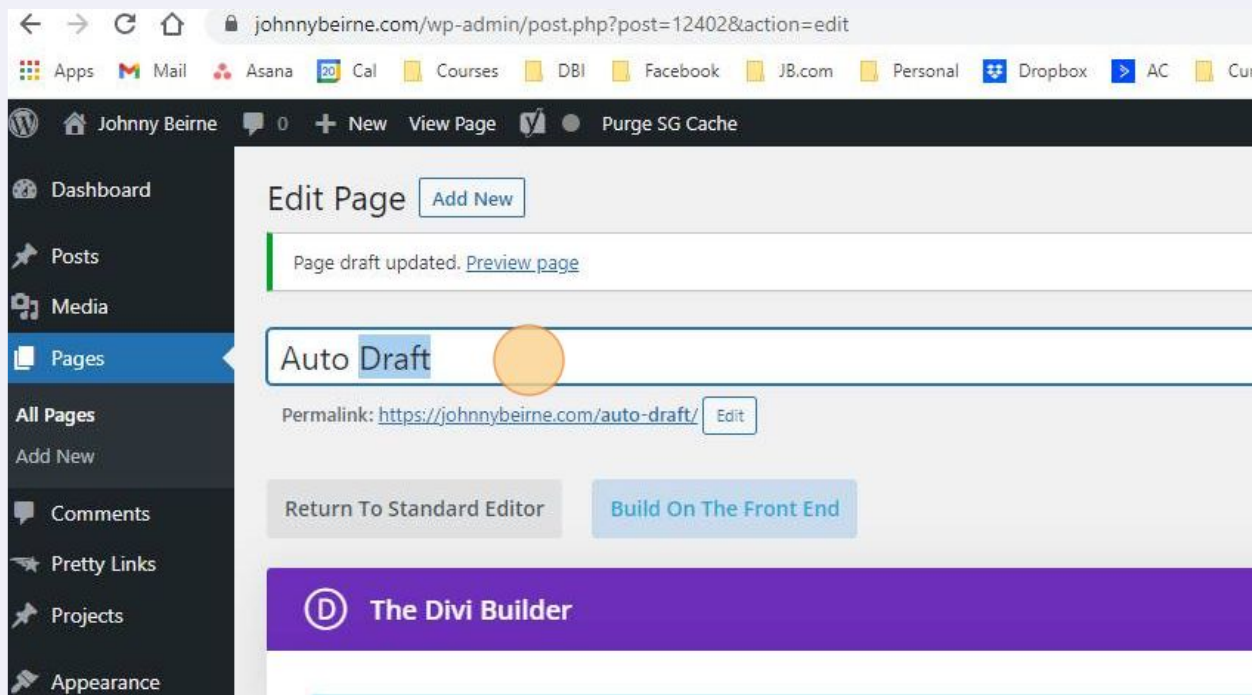
5 Choose the existing page you want to make a copy of

7 Click "Add title" - You can add your new page title at this point



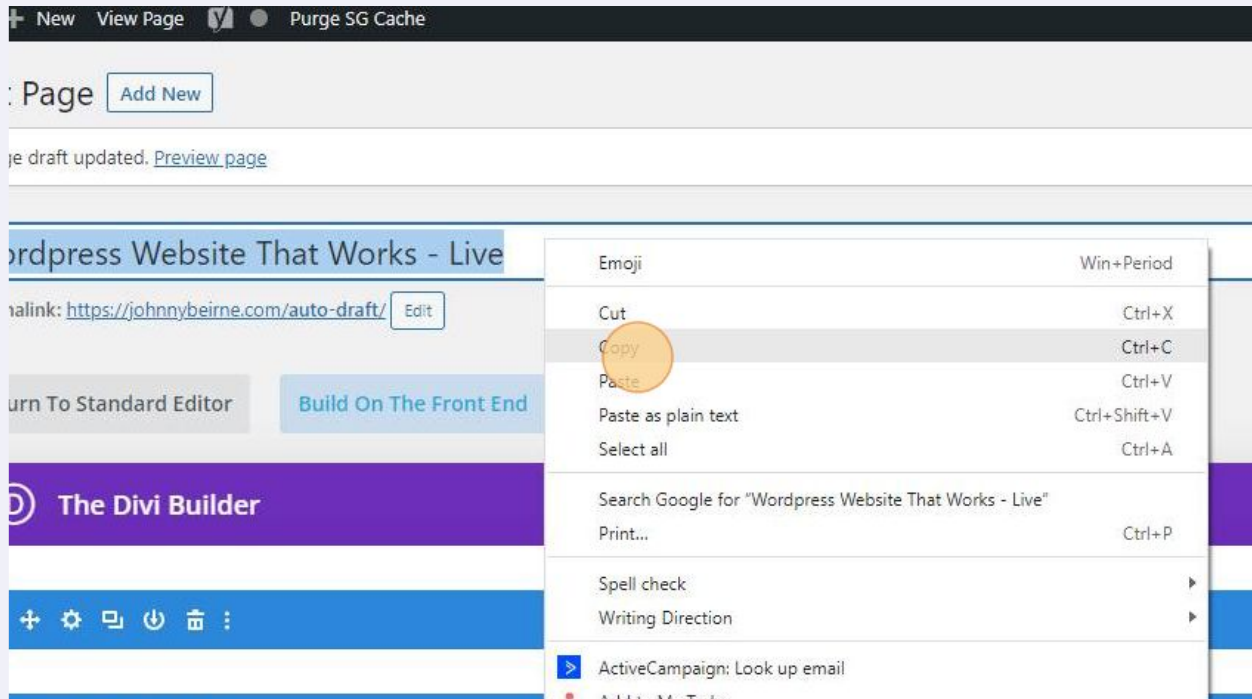
8 Type in your Page Title e.g. "Wordpress Websites That Work - Live"

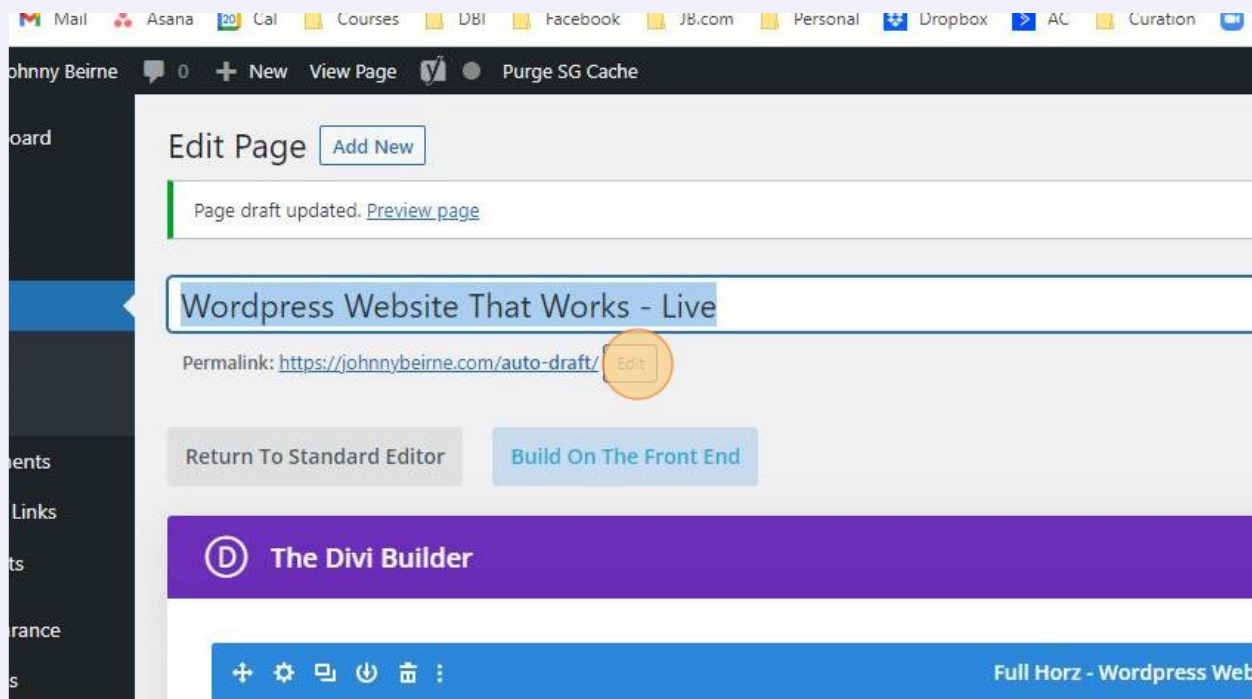

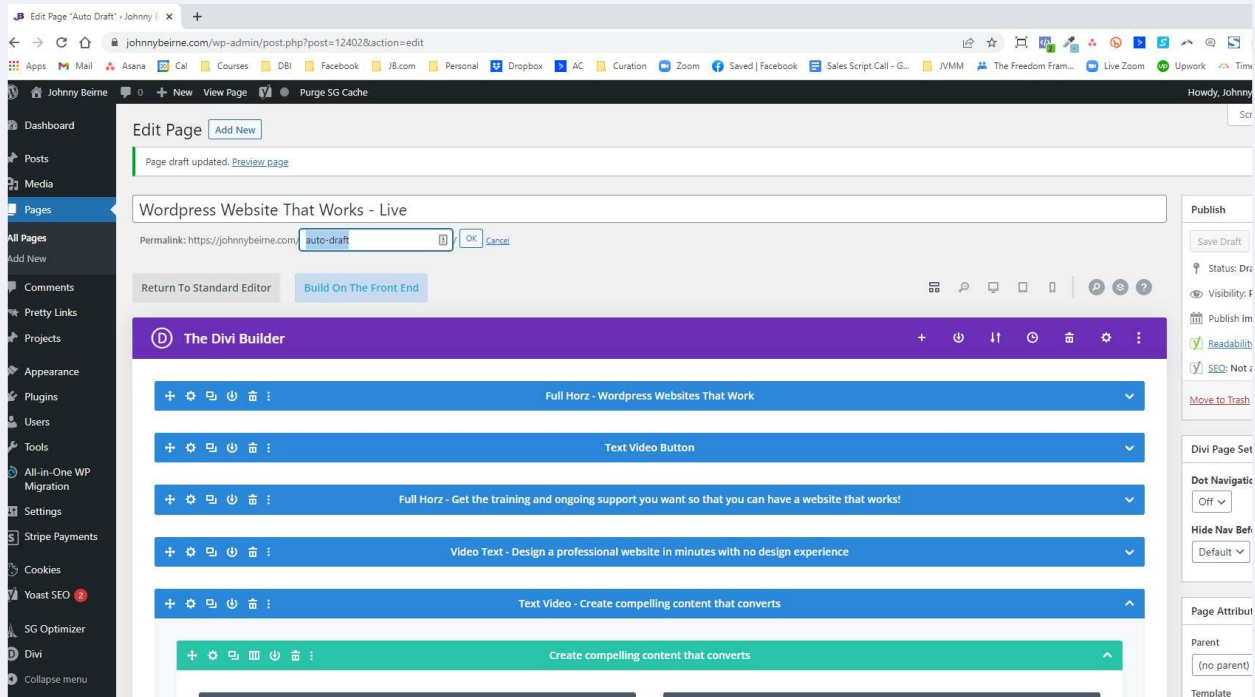

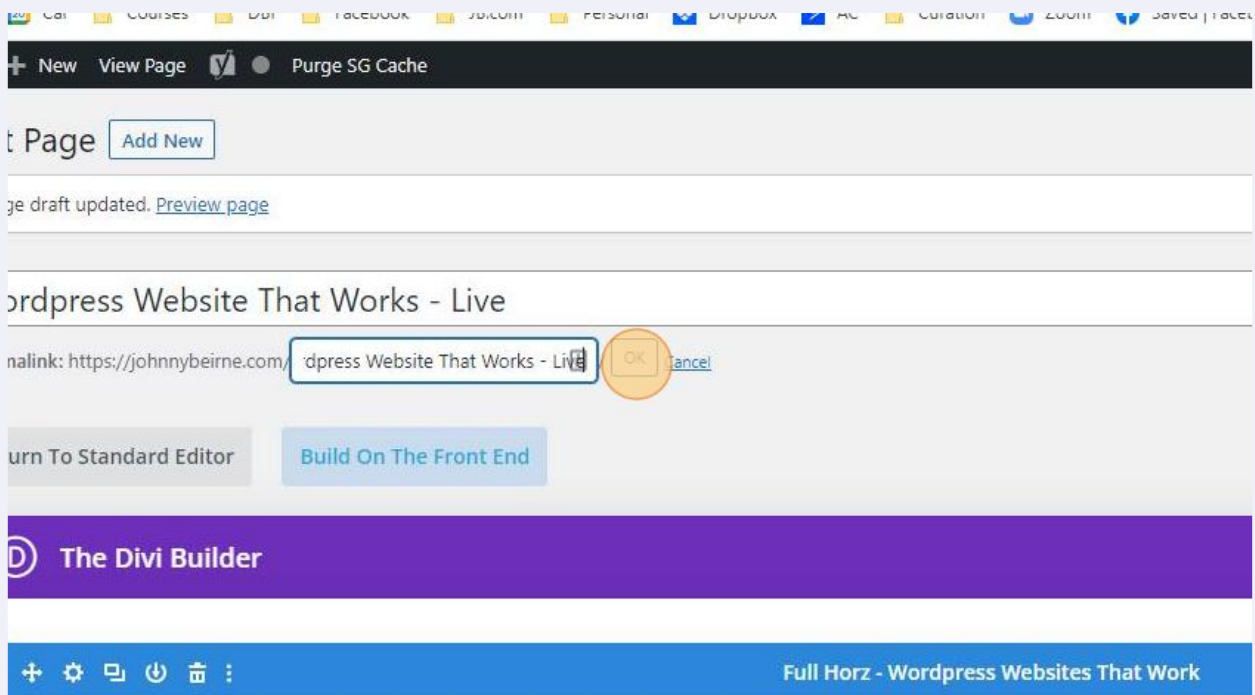
